PASTORAL COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE (Reviewed by this committee on 10th October 2016)

1. To support the Pastoral System, making recommendations to the Governing Body.
2. To liaise with the Assistant Head (Pastoral) and other pastoral staff.
3. To provide a Governors' Disciplinary Panel, to deal with extreme cases of behaviour.
4. To liaise and assist the Staffing Committee in matters of staff support.
5. Monitoring and Review of the School Development Plan as delegated by the Main Governing Body

DELEGATED POWERS

1. Student disciplinary matters
2. Appointment of a governor responsible for safeguarding (reviewed annually)
3. Policies relating to the pastoral committee may be ratified during a committee meeting with no requirement to be taken to the Main Governing Body Meeting (with the exception of SEN, Admissions, Behaviour Principles).

The Pastoral Committee meets once per term and has a quorum of three “core” committee members.
